Cooking Instructions

MICROWAVE OVEN: Arrange wings on microwave cooking sheet and heat on high power for 3 to 7 minutes.
CONVENTIONAL OVEN: Arrange wings on baking sheet and bake at 375°F for 25 to 35 minutes.
OVEN TEMPERATURES MAY VARY. Adjust cooking times accordingly.

Chicken Wing Sections, Water, Seasoning (Salt and Natural Flavor) and Sodium Phosphate. Glazed With: Glaze (Water, Sugar, Tomato Paste, Distilled Vinegar, Honey, Molasses, Modified Corn Starch, Salt, Smoke Flavor, Spices, Caramel Color, Garlic Powder, Onion Powder, Xanthan Gum, Corn Syrup Solids, Lemon Juice, Lemon Oil) and Water. Coated With: Wheat Flour, Modified Food Starch. Set in Soybean Oil.
